The Internet? Bah!

Hype Alert: Why cyberspace isn't, and will never be, nirvana

By CLIFFORD STOLL

After two decades online, I'm jaded now. It's not that I haven't had a ton of a good time on the Internet. I've met great people and even caught a hacker or two. But today I'm uneasy about this most trendy and oversold community. Visionaries see a future of telecommuting workers, interactive libraries and multimedia classrooms. They speak of electronic town meetings and virtual communities. Commerce and business will shift from offices and malls to networks and modems.

In the pretense of completeness, lacking editors, reviewers or critics, the Internet has become a wasteland of unfiltered data. You don't know what to ignore and what's worth reading. Logged onto the World Wide Web, I hunt for the date of the Battle of Trafalgar. Hundreds of files show up, and it takes 15 minutes to unravel them—one's a biography written by an eighth grader, the second is a computer game that doesn't work and the third is an image of a London monument. None answers my question, and my search is periodically interrupted by messages like, "Too many connections, try again later."





S. R. Ranganathan

Shiyali Ramamrita Ranganathan (* 9. August 1892 in Shiyali, Tamil Nadu; † 27. September 1972 in Bangalore) war ein indischer [Mathematiker](#) und Bibliothekswissenschaftler. Er schrieb das Werk „fünf Gesetze der Bibliothekswissenschaft“, die nicht sehr weit verbreitete, aber einflussreiche Colon-Klassifikation und prägte den Begriff der Informationslogistik. Er war ein Pionier der Bibliothekswissenschaft in Indien.

Seine fünfjährige Karriere als Professor für Mathematik an den Universitäten Mangalore, Coimbatore und Madras wurde durch sein Stottern erschwert (ein Handicap, das er im Laufe seines Lebens überwinden konnte).

Ursprünglich plante Ranganathan eine Karriere als Mathematiker. Er organisierte Sammlungen zu organischen Chemie und Mineralen.

Seine Kenntnisse auf dem Gebiet der Mathematik waren so ausgezeichnet, dass er sich entschied, eine Karriere als Bibliothekar einzuschlagen, um dort Bibliothekswesen zu studieren. Er schrieb 1932 die Grundzüge der Colon-Klassifikation (eine Facettenklassifikation).

- A lot correction wishes for the PND
- Wikipedia a good starting point for a search
- Wikipedia users can very easy become library users

Other Authority Files and Wikipedia

- GKD: Institutions
 - 100 links
 - finding the ID is very hard / no retrieval webservice (now)
 - Complicated structure

Other Authority Files and Wikipedia

- SWD: Keywords
 - Already over 250 links
 - finding the ID is very hard / no retrieval webservice now
- Czech Names Authority Files
 - about 800 Links

Further Ideas

- Links from the catalog to wikipedia
- linking of other authority files
- Links from Wikipedia to other resources (via Linkresolver)

Classification of Wikipedia

- via Social Tagging = categories
- Thoughts about classification with:
 - DDC (not free!)
 - RVK (only uses in Germany)
 - Basisclassification
 - UDC (not free, too)

Vision: A free classification for the net

Wikipedia: An Authority File for the net?

- very often linked
- One theme - one article eg. Wiki
- every wikipedia-link index an document with a theme
- article in every language has a persistent URL
- open for use in every context

Authority Files and Web 2.0

- Authority files can have a role in the web 2.0
- there must be an open interface/ service for retrieval
- everything that is indexed on the net with authority files can be easily integrated in a federated search
- O'Reilly: You have to find ways that your data get more important than more it will be used
